LEANANN Áras Éanna orthu ag óstáil ealaíontóirí agus ag reachtáil imeachtaí ar an oileán speisialta seo, Inis Oírr. Fáiltíonn an pobal Gaeltachta anseo roimh ealaíontóirí a chaitheann tréimhe linn ag fáil amach faoin oileán agus ag teacht ar smaointe nua chun ealaín iontach a chruthú. Bíonn méid áirithe cónaitheachtaí á dtairiscint againn gach bliain agus faigheann muid breis is 350 iarratas dóibh seo ó gach cearn den domhan. Reachtálann muid cónaitheachtaí freisin i gcomhpháirt le heagraíochtaí ealaíne, lena n-áirítear ISACS, RHA, Baboró agus oifig ealaíon Chomhairle Contae na Gaillimhe. Is iad na cónaitheachtaí croilár Áras Éanna mar go bhfuil buntáistí iontu don ealaíontóir agus don phobal.

Eagraíonn Áras Éanna imeachtaí do mhuintir na háite agus do chuariteoirí, ag cur Ealaín agus Ealaíontóirí os comhair an phobail inár n-amharclann, gailearaí agus ar fud an oileáin. Toisc cáil Áras Éanna a bheith ag méadú ar fud an domhain, táimid ag pleanáil don todhchaí agus ag obair ar phleananna forbartha as a dtiocfaidh Ionad Ealaíon den scoth chun cinn ar Inis Oírr tá súil againn, a bheidh anseo ar feadh na mblianta do na glúnta amach anseo.

Táimid ríméadach an clár imeachtaí seo a chur ar fáil daoibh agus tá súil againn go mbeifidh sibh taitneamh, sásamh agus pleisiúir as na himeachtaí ealaíne. Focal ón gCathaoirleach

Tá Áras Éanna thar a bheith sásta clár 2026 a chur i láthair. Mar Ionad Ealaíon Gaeltachta, an t-aon Ionad Ealaíon i gContae na Gaillimhe atá lonnaithe ar oileán — tá ár bhfís agus luachanna á gcur trasna go maith sa mheascán leathan léirithe, taispeántas agus féilte, atá curtha faoi réir ag ár stiúrthóir fuinniúil Dara McGee. Trinár gclár tá ealaín d'ardchaighdeán á chur ar fáil againn do phobal Inis Oírr agus dár n-aíonna agus cuairteoirí.

In éineacht lenár gclár imeachtaí cuireann muid clár cónaitheachta de chineálacha éagsúla ealaíne ar fáil in Áras Éanna, sna stiúideonna, san árasán, thart timpeall san oileán agus ar Inis Meáin. Cuireann na tréimhsí cónaitheachta spás agus suaimhneas ar fáil d'ealaíontóirí, timpeallacht chruthaitheach dá gcuid ealaíne agus deis teacht suas le smaointe nua agus cónaí ar feadh tamaill i dtimpeallacht spreagúil. Tá an-tóir ar ár gcónaitheachtaí, go náisiúnta agus go hidirnáisiúnta — agus d'fhéadfai na spásanna a bhíonn againn a líonadh an oiread seo babhtáí. Beidh an obair a chruthaítear, a chleachtar, a phéinteáiltear, a chumtar, agus a dheartar anseo le feiceáil ar fud an domhain.

Glacaimid buíochas lenár lucht maoinithe buanseasmhacha, leis an gComhairle Ealaíon, Comhairle Chontae na Gaillimhe agus Ealaíon na Gaeltachta mar nach bhféadfadh muid tabhairt faoi na rudaí seo gan a gcúnamh. Táimid buíoch freisin do na gnólachtaí agus daoine flaithiúla in Inis Oírr agus níos faide ó bhaile a chuidigh linn lenár gclár agus leis an bhfoirgneamh trí urraíocht, infheistíocht agus dea-mhéin. Is móir againn an lucht féachana a thagann chuig an amharclann, chuig na taispeántais mar aon le pobal tacúil agus cuidiúil Inis Oírr. Beidh foireann chumasach Áras Éanna, Dara McGee agus Oisín Ó Cualáin, le cúnaimh na saineolaithe teicniúla Pat Quinn agus Emma O'Grady ag obair ar feadh na bliana in Áras Éanna agus ar fud an oileáin chun an obair chruthaitheach seo san iarthar a threorú agus a choinneáil beo.

An chéad taispeántas riamh a bhí in Áras Éanna ba phictiúir mhóra le Mick Mulcahy iad agus sheas ceann amháin amach, íomhá de naomh gealgháireach leo féin ar charraig san iarthar. Taispeánadh na pictiúir mar pop-up speisiall sa seanfhoirgneamh a d'úsáid sé mar stiúideo tríocha sé bliain ó shin. Spreag an ócáid fíis nua don mhonarcha, go ndéanfaí ionad ealaíon galánta de, bhí sé ar nós go bhfaca Mulcahy siar san am sin an saothar iontach ealaíne a tharlódh sa fiche cúig bliain ina dhiaidh sin, ag baint úsáid iomlán as an spás, na stiúideonna, gailearaithe agus áit chónaithe, spreagtha agus tacaithe ag Inis Oírr, a thábhacht, teanga agus pobal. Anois in 2026 tá Áras Éanna fós ag leanacht ar aghaidh ag cruthú agus ag taispeáint ealaíne den scoth. Cuirimid fáilte romhat chuig Áras Éanna le bheith páirteach linn sa draíocht a bhaineann le healaín chumasach oileáin, ar imeall na hEorpa.

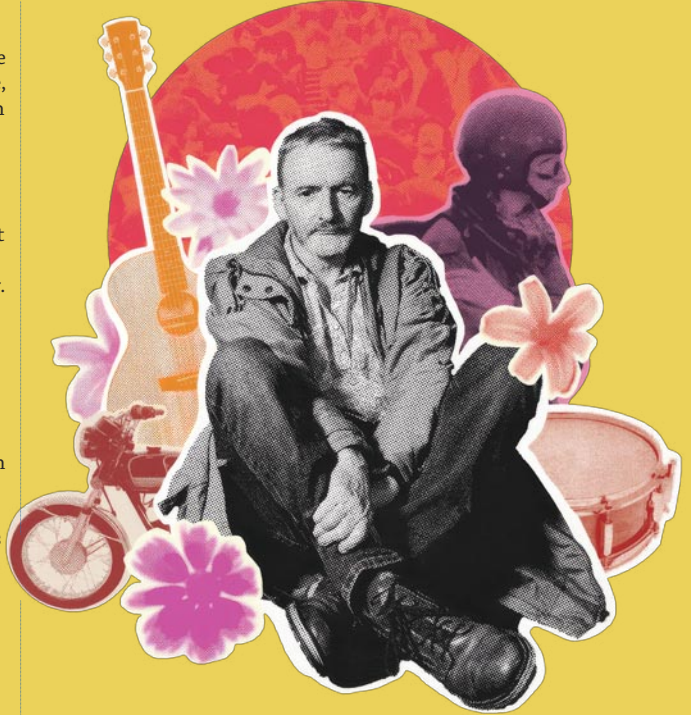
A one-man dramatic monologue by Frankie McCafferty • *Monalóg drámata aonair le Frankie McCafferty*

Sa bhliain 1983 a bhí an fhéile cheoil dheiridh i Lios Dúin Bhearna agus ar stáitse bhí Rory Gallagher, Christy Moore, Stockton's Wing, De Danann, Van Morrison, Moving Hearts agus tuilleadh. Ar fhaitíos nach raibh tú ann, nó go raibh tú ansin ach gur chaill tú amach air mar go raibh “rudaí eile” le déanamh agat tugann monalóg impriseanaíoch Frankie McCafferty léiriú breá air. Ar na príomhcharachtair tá an déagóir neamhurchóideach Macker agus a chomrádaithe as Dún na nGall, duine acu a bhí ag maíomh go mbeadh sé ina réalta rac-cheoil. Rinne roinnt cailíní as Tuaisceart Éireann an turas freisin agus súil ann go mbeadh coiscíní acusan tharla cosc a bheith fós orthu sa deisceart a bhí faoi chois an Chaitliceachais.

Tá ardmholadh ag dul do McCafferty as a ghrinneas súl agus as muid a thabhairt ar ais siar chuig an bhféile trí fhósa amharclannaíochta greannmhar, siamsúil agus oideachasúil.



RELIVING THE LAST LISDOONVARNA MUSIC FESTIVAL

The last music festival at Lisdoonvarna took place in 1983 with a line-up that included Rory Gallagher, Christy Moore, Stockton's Wing, Dé Danann, Van Morrison and Moving Hearts. In case you didn't get there, or got there and missed it because there were “other things” to do, Frankie McCafferty's impressionistic monologue offers a fine re-enactment of the adventure. The central characters

were the relatively innocent teenager Macker and his mates from Donegal, including one self-identifying as a future rock star. Also along for the ride, as it were, came some lasses from Northern Ireland who were expected to bring us the condoms that were still banned in the Catholic-oppressed south.

So, much kudos to McCafferty and his powers of observation for taking us back there with a piece of theatre that was funny, entertaining and educational.

In Iarthar na hÉireann atá Little John Nee ag cur faoi, scríbhneoir, taibheoir agus ceoltóir a bhfuil gradaim bronnata air. Tá a stíl féin aige den scéalaíocht cheolamharclannaíochta, atá greannmhar agus brónach ag an am céanna, agus aitheantas idirnáisiúnta bainte amach aige dá bharr.



Is cruthaitheoir bisiúil oibre é don amharclannaíocht agus toghadh mar bhall d'Aosdána é mar aitheantas ar an méid atá déanta aige ar son chultúr na hÉireann.

Áras Éanna are delighted to welcome Little John Nee's wonderful new show *Johnnys got a bus pass*. John has been presenting and performing his brilliant unique style theatre shows for many years here at Áras Éanna and it's always a treat when he brings a new production to the island.

Little John Nee is an award-winning writer, performer and musician based in the west of Ireland. He has developed a unique style of musical storytelling theatre, simultaneously hilarious and heart-breaking, that has won him international recognition. A prolific creator of work for theatre, he was elected to Aosdána in recognition of his contribution to Irish culture.



Trá Pháidín

Áit éicint leathbhealach idir *showband*, banna céilí agus *elastic band* a gheobhaidh tú Trá Pháidín. Is iomaí cur síos atá luaite leis an mbanna: ó snagcheol go ceol traidisiúnta go ceol cosmach.

Tá dhá EP agus 3 albam eisithe ag Trá Pháidín go dtí seo. Ina measc tá *An 424*, albam bunaithe ar thuras shíce-gheografaíochta an bus 424 a théann ó Charna go Bhearna tríd Ghaeltacht Chonamara isteach go dtí cathair na Gaillimhe.

Is léargas é an t-albam den cumasc idir “phearsantachtaí” an bhus, tionchar tirdreacht an R336 agus an aigne solúbtha den Ghaeltacht’s Ghalltacht, uilig cáite isteach le samhlaíocht sláim ceoltóirí ó culraí difriúil.

Tá Albam na Bliana Gradam Nós 2023 bainte amach ag *An 424* agus é á chasadh chomh fada siar le Nua Eabhrac agus soir leis an tSeapáin, le léirmheasanna fláthúla ar fud na cruinne.

Trá Pháidín exist somewhere between a showband, a céilí band and an elastic band. Their sound has inspired all kinds of descriptions, from “jazz with traditional music” to “cosmic” — but none of these do their sound justice. The group has released two EPs and three albums, including *An 424*, a record inspired by a psychogeographical journey on the 424 bus route, which travels from Carna to Barna through the Connemara Gaeltacht and on into Galway City.

An 424 is a richly idiosyncratic work, shaped by the bus’s shifting “personalities,” the landscape of the R336, and the fluid mental and cultural terrain between Gaeltacht and Galltacht. The result is an imaginative and deeply distinctive album, brought to life by musicians from a range of different backgrounds.

Winner of the Nós Album of the Year Award 2023, *An 424* has found its way onto turntables as far west as New York and as far east as Japan, earning widespread acclaim along the way.

Is é Ger amhránaí reatha Bhanna Céilí Chill Fhionnúrach. Ina theannta sin, oibríonn sé mar innealtóir taifeadta agus mar cheoltóir le go leor ealaíontóirí eile ar nós Sharon Shannon, Seán Keane agus Moncrieff.

Is as Corcaigh do Clare, fídléir den tséú glúin agus amhránaí dátheangach. Tarraingíonn sí ar cheol a sinsear, agus fionn sí fréamhacha traidisiúnta Gaelacha le fuaimeanna agus tionchair chomhaimseartha. Tá a cuid amhrán nasctha le háit, ag tabhairt béaloideas, teanga agus gníomhaíochas le chéile sa cheol. Tá cáil uirthi as a fuinneamh bríomhar agus spreagúil — tá spiorad neamheaglach ar nós gaiscíoch aici, a spreagann agus a aontaíonn lucht éisteachta timpeall an domhain.

Ag dul lena saothair nuálacha ceoil tá léirithe beo spleodra — tugann sí a lucht éisteachta ar aistear iontach lán le dóchas, amhránaíocht, ceiliúradh agus croí.

Bhí an ceoltóir Éireannach, Maria Somerville, imithe as a háit dúchais i gConamara le fada an lá faoin am ar thosaigh sí ag scríobh *Luster*, a céad albam don lipéad 4AD.

D'fhás sí suas faoin tuath i dtírdhreach fiáin sléibhtiúil chósta thiar na Gaillimhe agus bhog sí ina dhiaidh sin go Baile Átha Cliath, áit ar thóg sí a ham ag forbairt stíl ceoil atmaisféarach dream pop a bhí spreagtha ag tírdhreach a hóige — domhan fuaime draíochtúil leictreonaice, strumáil aerga giotáir, cnagadh éadlúth, agus lirici íseal ceoil.

Is iar-ealaíontóir cónaithe ag Áras Éanna i Marie.

By the time Maria Somerville started writing *Luster*, her landmark label debut for 4AD, she had lived away from her native Connemara for quite some time.

Having grown up amongst the wild, mountainous terrain of

Galway's rural west coast, she later relocated to Dublin, where she patiently developed an atmospheric dream pop signature inspired by the landscape of her youth — a spellbinding

soundworld of gusting ambient electronics, ethereal guitar strums, sparse percussion, and hushed lyrical vignettes.

Maria is a former artist in residence at Áras Éanna.

Ceoltóir, taibheoir agus scríbhneoir as Conamara is ea Olan Monk. Cumadh an t-albam *Songs for Nothing* tar éis dó filleadh ar chósta thiar na hÉireann. Tarraingíonn an t-albam ar amhránaíocht shean-nóis agus liriciúlacht fhaoistiniúil Shinéad O'Connor, ag meascadh traidisiún Éireannach le rac gotach trialach. Trí uigeacht éagsúil *shoegaze*, *cloudrap* agus foinn mhalla músclaíonn an t-albam tírdhreach Chonamara mar aon le mothú domhain áite.

Olan Monk is a musician, performer, and writer from Conamara, Ireland. Their second album, *Songs for*

Nothing, is out now on AD 93.

Written after Monk's return to Ireland's west coast, the record draws from sean-nós singing and Sinéad O'Connor's confessional lyricism, blending Irish tradition with experimental gothic art rock. Through shifting textures of shoegaze, cloud rap, and slow airs, the album evokes Conamara's rugged landscape and a deep sense of place.

Ó na gcéad uair ar stáitse do Thír éad Mháirtín O'Connor ag tús na 2000idí tá camchuairt tugtha acu ar fud an domhain agus dhá thaifeadadh déanta acu, *Crossroads* agus *Going Places* a fuair moladh mór ó léirmheastóirí.

Chaith Máirtín O'Connor tréimhse antioncharach le De Danann, Midnight Well, Skylark, agus tá sé ar dhuine de na ceoltóirí is fearr a bhí in Éirinn riamh.

Tá Craobh Uile-Éireann bainte amach ag Cathal Hayden ar an bhfidil agus ar an mbainseó. agus is ball bunaidh den sárghrúpa Four Men and a Dog é.

Tá clú agus cáil bainte amach ag an t-ionstraimí Seamie O'Dowd mar dhuine de na ceoltóirí is fearr in Éirinn. Bhí sé ar chamchuairt domhanda ar feadh sé bliana le Dervish, agus d'oibrigh sé freisin mar léiritheoir agus mar cheoltóir seisiún ar roinnt taifeadtaí a thuill ardmholadh ó léirmheastóirí.

Since The Máirtín O'Connor Trio's first performance in Sligo in the early 2000s, they've toured worldwide as well as making two critically acclaimed recordings, *Crossroads* and *Going Places*.

Máirtín O'Connor's own musical history encompasses an influential spell with Dé Danann, Midnight Well, Skylark, and is one of the finest all-round musicians that Ireland has ever produced.

Cathal Hayden is an All-Ireland champion on fiddle as well as banjo, an enduring and much cited inspiration for emerging traditional musicians and a founder member of super group Four Men and a Dog.

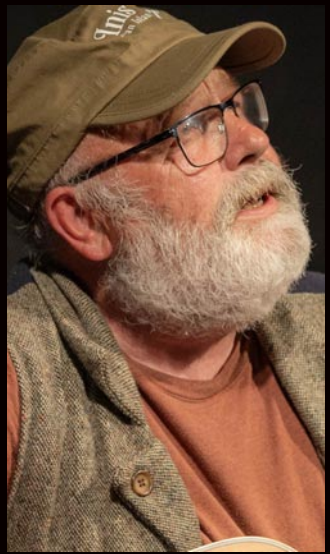

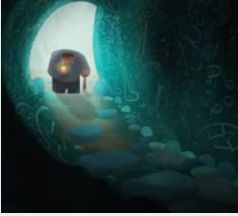

buan eatarthu. Ghríosaigh Derek James le tabhairt faoin bpéintéireacht agus bhíodh sé ag seoladh ábhar chuige ó am go ham ach ní bhacfaidh sé leis na scuaba mar go mbíodh James ag iarraidh a chuid scuab féin a dhéanamh as eireball a asail. Sin é an chaoi ar thosaigh scoil phéintéireachta Thoráí amach.

Trína gcuid péintéireachta rinne na healaíontóirí seo taifead uathúil de shaol an oileáin. I measc na ndaoine a bhí páirteach sa scoil phéintéireachta a bunaíodh bhí Patsai Dan Mac Ruaidhrí (Rí Thoráí), Ruairí Rodgers, John Dixon agus James Rodgers agus ón dara glúin an fear fíorchumasach Anton Meenan. Tory Island Painters

Opening: Sunday, 5 July, 13:00, Áras Éanna

The rugged scenic Tory Island is an island situated 11km of the North-West coast of Co. Donegal. The Gaeltacht (Irish speaking) island is steeped in history and mythology and is the home to the Tory school of painters.

The renowned English artist Derek Hill (b.1916- d.2000) became a frequent visitor to the island in the 1950's where he worked from a small hut studio (formally a Lloyds of London shipping signal hut) painting the wild landscapes and portraits of the islanders.

On one such occasion while out painting an islander by the name of James Dixon came upon him while he worked. Derek asked him what he thought of his painting and James simply answered 'I think I could do better myself'... this amused Derek and it sparked a lasting friendship between them. Derek encouraged James to paint and would send him materials from time to time but not brushes as James preferred to make his own brushes from his donkeys tail. This was the beginning of the Tory school of painters.

These artists through their painting captured a unique record of island life. The school of painters that developed included Patsy Dan Rodgers (King of Tory), Ruairí Rodgers, John Dixon and James Rodgers with a second generation including the very talented Anton Meenan. Áras Éanna is delighted to present this exhibition, showcasing a new generation of artists who continue the legacy of the Tory Island painters, a movement born from the chance encounter between Derek Hill and James Dixon in the 1950s.

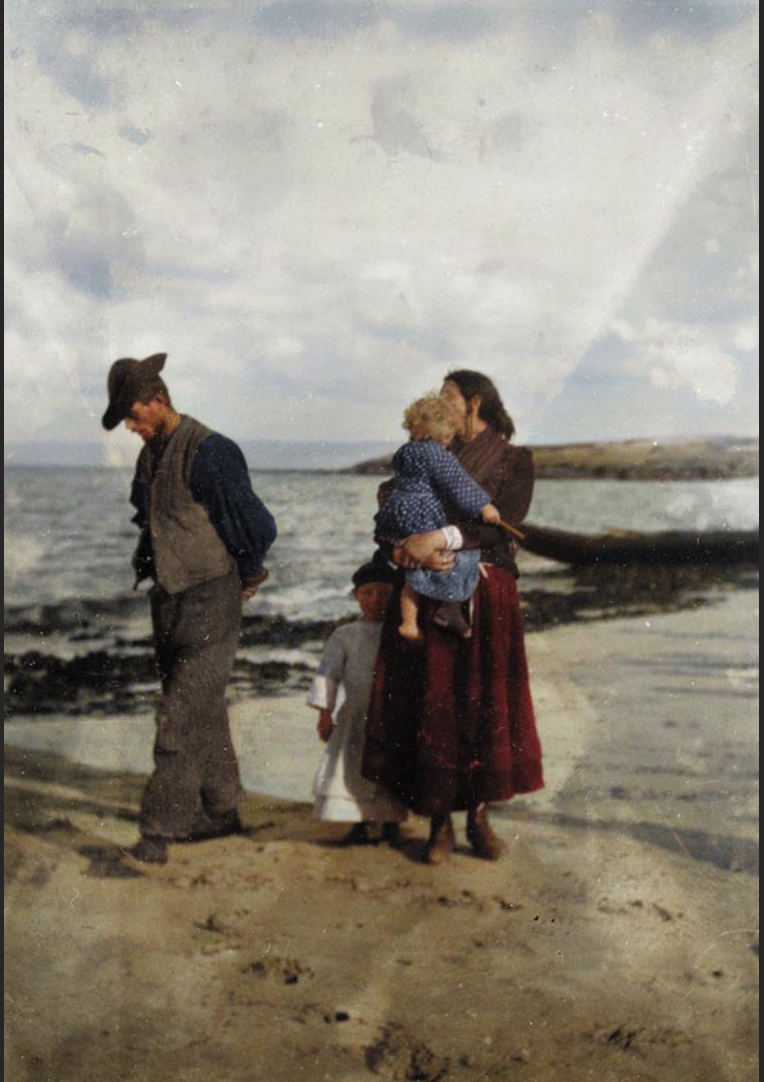

Every year Áras Éanna selects two artists on invited residencies whose work has made an indelible impact on art in Ireland.



Dolores Lyne

Is amharc-ealaíontóir í Dolores Lyne atá lonnaithe in iarthar na hÉireann. Ina saothar tugann sí tírdhreach, cuimhne, seandálaíocht agus stair le chéile trí chleachtas péintéireachta bunaithe ar dhianthaighde. Is as Cill Airne, Contae Chiarraí di ó thús ach tar éis di cur fúithi i nGaillimh d'athraigh a fócas ealaíne siar i dtreo Chonamara, na hoileáin amach ón gcósta ansin, agus rian na ndaoine atá lonnaithe sna háiteanna sin.

Baineann a saothar ach go háirithe le tírdhreach chósta Chonamara, na hoileáin amach ó Inis Bó Finne, láithreáin ón gCré-Umhaois agus láithreáin deasghnácha in áiteanna ar nós An Rátha agus Uachtar Ard. Idir an phéintéireacht agus cineálacha ábhartha meáin mheasctha scrúdaíonn sí an talamh mar choimeádán do shaoil an duine agus an dúlra, ag nascadh taithí comhaimseartha, staire agus seandálaíochta.

Bhí taispeántais ag Lyne i go leor áiteanna, ag áireamh i nGailearaí Ealaíne Russell, áit ar thaispeáin sí Westland in 2007 agus SOLID BURREN in 2016. I measc a tionscnamh le déanaí tá *To the Letter* (2023), mórthaispeántas bunaithe ar litreacha a seanuncail, an Ginearál Liam Ó Loingsigh, inar rianaigh sí ábhar a chomhfhreagrás trí shraith móroibreacha go dtí an áit ar scríobhadh iad.

Mhúnlaigh an bhaint a bhí aici le Tionscnamh Inis Laighean a cleachtas freisin, tréimhse a chaith sí mar ealaíontóir leabaithe ag tochailtí seandálaíochta amach ó Inis Bó Finne.

Tá a saothar le feiceáil i roinnt bailiúchán poiblí agus institiúideach, lena n-áirítear bailiúcháin a bhaineann le hOifig na nOibreacha Poiblí, Comhairle Ealaíon na hÉireann, Banc na hÉireann agus Ollscoil na Gaillimhe.

Dolores Lyne

Dolores Lyne is an Irish visual artist based in the west of Ireland whose work brings together landscape, memory, archaeology, and history through a deeply researched painting practice. Originally from Killarney, County Kerry, and later based in Galway, Lyne's artistic focus shifted westward toward Connemara, its offshore islands, and the traces of human presence embedded in those places.

Her work is especially associated with the coastal landscapes of Connemara, the islands off Inishbofin, and Bronze Age and ritual sites in places such as Raha and Oughterard. Across painting and related mixed-media approaches, she explores land as a container for human and natural life, linking contemporary experience with older historical and archaeological layers.

Lyne has exhibited widely, including at the Russell Gallery, where she showed in Westland in 2007 and SOLID BURREN in 2016. More recent projects include *To the Letter* (2023), a major exhibition developed from the letters of her granduncle General Liam Lynch, tracing the content of his correspondence through a series of large-scale works back to where they were written.

Her practice has also been shaped by her involvement with the Inishlyon Project, where she spent time as an embedded artist on archaeological digs off Inishbofin.

Lyne's work is represented in a number of public and institutional collections, including holdings associated with the OPW, the Arts Council of Ireland, Bank of Ireland, and University of Galway.

Little John Nee

Is scríbhneoir, taibheoir, scéalaí agus ceoltóir é Little John Nee a shníonn idir an amharclannaíocht, an ceol, an fhilíocht, an chleasaíocht agus an monalóg liriciúil. Lonnaithe in iarthar na hÉireann dó, tá breis agus daichead bliain caite aige ag cruthú amharclannaíocht scéalaíochta cheolmhar.

I nGlaschú a saolaíodh é agus is i Leitir Ceanainn a tógadh é. Chuir sé tús lena shaol taibhithe i mbannaí punc sular fhorbair sé cleachtas a chuimsigh taibhléiriú sráide, amharclannaíocht, raidió, ceol agus beo-ealaín. Tar éis dó filleadh ar Éirinn go luath sna 1980idí, bhí sé mar chuid de ghlúin d'ealaíontóirí neamhspleácha a d'athraigh tírdhreach na taibhléirithe. Bhog sé go Gaillimh i 1986 áit a d'oibrigh sé le Macnas.

Tá corpas saothair aitheanta cruthaithe aige ina aonar agus i gcomhar le daoine eile, ina measc *The Derry Boat*, *Limavady My Heart's Delight*, *Dead Rooster Blues*, *Radio Rosario*, agus le gairid *Nettle Horse* agus *The Art of Gentle Punk*. Tá a chuid drámaí agus taibhithe coimisiúnaithe ag eagraíochtaí ar nós Fhéile Ealaíon an Earagail, Axis Bhaile Munna, Comhairlí Contae Dhún na nGall agus Liatroma, agus Féile Ealaíon na Gaillimhe.

In 2016, toghadh mar bhall d'Aosdána é, mar aitheantas ar an gcion den scoth atá déanta aige do na healaíona cruthaitheacha in Éirinn.

Little John Nee

Little John Nee is an Irish writer, performer, storyteller, and musician whose work moves fluidly between theatre, song, poetry, clown, and lyrical monologue. Based in the west of Ireland, he has spent more than four decades creating a distinctive form of musical storytelling theatre.

Born in Glasgow and raised partly in Letterkenny, Nee began performing in punk bands before developing a wider practice across street performance, theatre, radio, music, and live art. After returning to Ireland in the early 1980s, he became part of a generation of independent makers who reshaped the performance landscape, later moving to Galway in 1986 and performing for many years with Macnas.

Over the years he has created an acclaimed body of solo and collaborative work, including *The Derry Boat*, *Limavady My Heart's Delight*, *Dead Rooster Blues*, *Radio Rosario*, and more recently *Nettle Horse* and *The Art of Gentle Punk*. His plays and performances have been commissioned by organisations including Earagail Arts Festival, Axis Ballymun, Donegal County Council, Leitrim County Council, and Galway Arts Festival.

In 2016 he was elected to Aosdána, in recognition of his outstanding contribution to the creative arts in Ireland.

Philip Fogarty

“Before the arrival of mass media, there used to be much less of a difference between the so-called performer and the audience. I think it’s good if you can create work which can make that connection happen.”

Fogarty’s work deploy’s live and recorded audio and visual materials alongside live-generated music, sound and imagery. Visitors’ movements and sounds are taken up and responded to sonically and visually through the use of motion and audio sensing, and visitors find themselves immersed in and participating in the work.

“I like that this sort of form can be approached on any level, by anybody, regardless of age or cultural references. You can make what you want of it — it could be for reflection, or for an exploration of sound and visual processes, or just having a bit of fun.”

“I had such a wonderful stay. I felt like royalty. Dara and Aisling were so helpful and supportive. Anything I needed, they were there.”

Teresa Doyle

In recent years, my work has led me to doll-making—each piece a vessel for storytelling. It felt vital for me to connect with the islanders. As part of my residency I wanted to research traditional clothing that the men and women of the Island wore, how it was made, and to create two dolls in their likeness. Mary McCarthy was a wonderful guide with all her knowledge about these garments and this enabled me to create ‘Éanna agus Máire Brigid’.

Visiting the schools, meeting the youth, and hearing their voices became an important part of my time there also. I am truly grateful for this experience. It was a time that nourished both my art and my spirit, leaving me with a renewed sense of purpose and connection that I will carry forward into my work.
